

## Kidnapping Emergencies

When a person is kidnapped, they are taken against their will, usually by threats made against them or through lies and deceit. It is critical to quickly identify a call reporting a kidnapping incident and dispatch the appropriate response.

The purpose of this class is to familiarize telecommunicators with callers reporting kidnapping emergencies. You will learn the definition of kidnapping and a process to gather pertinent information that can assist emergency responders in locating the victim.

### Goals

Upon completion of this course, the student will be able to demonstrate the following skills.

1. Discuss the differences between a kidnapping and a missing person.
2. List several questions to ask the caller that can expedite the appropriate response to a kidnapping.
3. Explain how caller party impacts how a call is handled by the telecommunicator.
4. Explain the role of an Amber Alert in kidnapping cases.
