

Public Indecency

This course familiarizes telecommunicators with different types of public indecency and identifies the necessary information to gather from callers reporting this crime. It also discusses why this type of behavior is categorized as a sex crime and the impact it can have on those that witness acts of public indecency. Familiarizing yourself with the topic of public indecency helps ensure that you can maintain your composure and treat callers who report this activity with sensitivity and understanding.

Goals

Upon completion of this course, the student will be able to demonstrate the following skills.

1. Define public indecency.
2. Identify what constitutes an act of public indecency in your state.
3. Explain the critical details to gather from a caller reporting a public indecency incident.
4. Recognize ways to display sensitivity to a caller reporting a public indecency incident.
