



Aircraft Incidents

In this course, you learn about different types of aircraft incident calls and how to determine what information should be gathered based on the location of the aircraft and the caller. You also learn to identify different types of aircraft and their key components to better assess the nature of the emergency and any potential hazards that may be present.

- 2. Describe various types of aircraft and their key components.
- 3. Explain the types of responses required for different crash sites.
