

Outside Fires

In this course, you learn about the different types of outside fire calls that telecommunicators may receive and the potential hazards they present. You also explore the information gathering process used during an outside fire call and explain the appropriate Pre-Arrival Instructions to provide to the caller.

1. Identify the types of outside fires and their associated hazards.
2. Explain the information gathering process used when handling a call about an outside fire.
3. Describe the appropriate Pre-Arrival Instructions to give callers reporting an outside fire.
